Attachment A

Section 12.25.071 Truck Parking prohibitions and/or restrictions in the public right-of-way.

- A. It is unlawful to park or leave standing any of the following within the public right-of-way on any highway, street, road, alley or on any public property within the city:
1. Any vehicle or trailer which contains any hazardous substance as defined in Section 2452 of the California Vehicle Code;
 2. Any unattached trailer, including, but not limited to, utility trailer, boat trailer, boat, camper, camper shell, camp trailer, livestock trailer, trailer coach, or semi-trailer which is non self-propelled, non-motorized, or not capable of movement under its own power;
 3. It is unlawful to park or leave standing any large commercial vehicle, truck tractor and semi-trailer or truck tractor having a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of ten thousand (10,000) pounds or more within the public right-of-way as described in this section. For the purposes of this section, the term "large commercial vehicle" shall include commercial vehicles that exceed a width of eighty (94) inches, or exceeds a height of seven (7) feet, or exceeds a length of twenty-five (25) feet.
 - a. On any highway, street, road, or alley within any residential district within the city;
 - b. On any highway, street, road, or alley within one hundred (100) feet of any residential dwelling;
 - c. Within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any driveway opening;
 - d. Within any commercially zoned property for the purpose other than doing business at the site, or for the purpose not related to such business operation, or remaining parked or standing for longer than reasonably appropriate to do such business or acts related to such business operations;
 - e. On any alley within the city;
 - f. On any highway, street or road which is adjacent to a parcel upon which there exists a public facility. Within the meaning of this subsection, "public facility" includes, but is not limited to, parks, schools and civic buildings;
 - g. While adjacent to a developed residential area within the city, the operator shall not idle the vehicle's engine for longer than five minutes

B. Exceptions. See Sec.12.25.130 - Commercial vehicles and Section 12.35.020 G - Vehicles Exempt.

TRUCK PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF WAY

BACKGROUND

The City of Jurupa Valley has experienced widespread truck parking issues in the City's right-of-way and there is insufficient language in our Municipal Code for Code Enforcement Officers or Sherriff Officers to issue appropriate citations. City staff presented the item to the Public Works Advisory Committee on January 11, 2024 and has updated language to the draft truck parking restriction ordinance based on the feedback received. Staff is seeking additional input from the Committee before recommending approval to the City Council.

ANALYSIS

Truck parking is a growing concern throughout the City. Implementing a truck parking restrictions would enable them to effectively regulate and cite offenders for violations. This measure aims to address the challenges posed by unauthorized truck parking, fostering a safer and more orderly environment. By enforcing this regulation, the city can mitigate traffic congestion, enhance public safety, and maintain the overall aesthetic appeal of the community. Additionally, it underscores the commitment to upholding city ordinances, promoting responsible parking practices, and ensuring the well-being and convenience of all residents and visitors.

Staff compared similar truck parking restrictions by other public agencies and took into account feedback obtained from the public and the Committee. The draft language under consideration can be added as Section 12.25.071 to the Municipal Code and it can read as follows in Attachment A. This draft ordinance captures only truck parking in the public right-of-way and not on private property.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed amended ordinance is projected to have minimal financial impact on the City.
