- Pay impound fee
- Provide valid I.D. and proof of ownership
- Complete 2-hour educational class

MOBILE VENDING REQUIREMENTS

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



REQUIRED PERMITS

Locations must be approved prior to submitting
- **Provide Proof of Auto Insurance**
- **Provide Certificate of Liability Insurance**
City of Jurupa Valley listed as additional Certificate Holder
Minimum of \$1,000,000 insurance coverage
- **Valid CA Driver's License or CA ID Card**
- **Provide a 3x5 or 4x6 photo of Vehicle or Cart (Rear and Sides)**
- **Site Development or Temporary Event Permit (if applicable)**

Operating on Public Right of Way

Allowed Hours: 7:00 AM – 10:00 PM

Keep Distance:

- 5 ft. from vendors
- 50 ft. from intersections
- 300 ft. from schools (7:00 AM–5:00 PM)

Unsafe Zones: Medians, unimproved areas, non-motorized carts on streets.

Sidewalks: 5 ft. clearance, no tables or chairs.

Vehicles: Follow parking laws, no sidewalk encroachment, serve from rear or curbside only.

Permits: Carry physical copy of City, Health, and Seller's Permit.

Sales: Collect tax, give receipts with full details.

Cleanliness: Provide trash bin, clean 25 ft. radius of operation.

Prohibited: No vending within 200 ft. of permitted farmers markets or events.

Parks/Residential: Roaming allowed with permission; stationery not allowed.

Operating on Private Property

Vendors must comply with zoning laws and obtain property owner's consent

Obtain a City Permit

- ≤ 5 days/year: Temporary Event Permit
- ≥ 6 days/year: Site Development Permit

Operate a minimum of 5 ft. from other vendors

- No vending within 300 ft. of schools (7:00 AM– 5:00 PM on school days)

Physically Carry

- Health Permits
- City Vending Permit
- Any other required Permits

Follow all laws including ADA and Fire Codes

Provide trash bin and clean up within area
